Partner Criteria

To be include as a partner on the orca.wa.gov Web site, organizations must meet more than one of the following criteria:

- Be a non-governmental, not-for profit organization aligned with orca recovery.
- Be a government or tribal organization aligned with orca recovery.
- Be an organization identified as a participant in the Governor's Southern Resident Killer Whale Task Force.
- Be an organization with a mission statement of orca recovery (management, conservation, science, or education and outreach).
- Be an organization with a current and strong influence on the Salish Sea and orca recovery (management, conservation, science, or education and outreach) that directly influences Southern Resident orcas.
- Be an organization participating in multiple areas of orca recovery including multiple geographic locations (not a single-focus geographic site or single-site issue).
